Weekend Workshop

The Workshop will be held at St Joseph's on the Strand with Ruth Wilkinson being the lead tutor. Ruth has led two workshops in Townsville before and jumped at the opportunity to come here again.

She is planning to bring the violinist Cynthia O'Brien with her and they are planning a join concert on Tuesday 30th July. Cynthia may give a strings workshop to coincide with our own if there is sufficient interest from local strings players.

Noye's Fludde

The Australian Festival of Chamber Music has invited the Society to participate in a performance of Noye's Fludde (Noah's Flood) by Benjamin Britten at the Family Concert. The music is scored for a small ensemble of professional players and a larger amateur ensemble called the ripieno. Ruth Wilkinson, the visiting tutor for our weekend workshop on the previous weekend has been invited to join the professional players and we are to supply up to 12 descant and treble recorder players for the ripieno.

This is a great opportunity for members who wish to participate and a chance for the Society to raise its profile in Townsville.
